Is God calling you to ministry?

The Diocese of Truro is offering an exciting and fulfilling internship experience for young people (18-30ish) who believe that God might be calling them to Christian ministry.

You will gain parish experience in the varied church contexts in and around Falmouth, with opportunities to experience and lead different styles of rural, semi-urban and youth ministry.

There is the opportunity to spend one day a week on a placement outside the parish context. Placements include working with St Petroc's Society for the homeless, experiencing Christian leadership and ministry at Truro Cathedral, and chaplaincy at Exeter and Falmouth University and the Royal Cornwall Hospital in Truro.

You will live in community with up to 3 others on the same journey, in a former vicarage near the heart of the town. There will be space to pray, study theology alongside local ordinands, and reflect on God's call for you. Board, lodging and living expenses are included.

This internship offers a clear pathway to help you discern your calling to lay or ordained ministry.
